The day ended with 3A winning among the 3^{rd} years, 2C winning the 2^{nd} years, and 1A winning in the 1^{st} year group.

While Covid-19 is not as serious as it was last year, with the idea of 'safety first', Keika held our annual Keika Festival online. Many students from various clubs created videos to showcase what they have done this year, and these videos were made available online over the weekend that the Keika Festival is normally held. From the Guitar club to the Track and Field club, from the Calculator club to the Student Council, there was a wide range of videos that the students at Kei-sho had made.

In addition to Kei-sho, some videos were made available to everyone at Keika. The ensemble band, marching band, Kei-sho's Dance Club, and the traditional Biblio-Battle were made available on a special, limited-time stage, where everyone at Keika could watch them.

While it is unfortunate that the Keika Festival could not be held in person, the students did a great job in making their videos and maintaining the spirit of Keika.

In October, we have had 2 of our big events for the year, and the students, as well as the teachers, have enjoyed the change of pace.
