The Soviet Union launched the first man-made satellite, called Sputnik, in 1957. It was the very first object sent into space. Two years later, they launched Luna 2. This drove the United States and the Soviet Union toward a “space race” to see which country would be the first to send humans into space and which would be the first to reach the moon. This race led to new technologies and the creation of NASA in the United States.

The United States created NASA in 1958 and started the Mercury project in 1960. This was a project to test if humans could survive in space. They decided to have an American reach the moon by the end of the 1960s. On May 5, 1961, Alan Shepard became the first American to travel into space. He was less than one month behind the Soviet astronaut, Yuri Gagarin. He made the historical “*first flight*” in the same year.
