Over time, the Michelin Guide changed. It began to talk more about restaurants. In 1926, the guide started to give stars to restaurants. These stars showed how good the food was. Today, many people around the world know these stars.

The Michelin Guide uses one, two, or three stars. One star means the restaurant is very good. Two stars mean the food is excellent and worth a visit. Three stars mean the food is amazing, and worth a special trip. Getting stars is very important for chefs and restaurant owners.

The guide has special workers called ^{*2}inspectors. Inspectors visit restaurants secretly. They do not tell anyone who they are. They pay for their food like normal guests. They check the food, the taste, and how the food is cooked. They also check if the food is always good. They do not care about the style of the room or the music.

Today, the Michelin Guide is in many countries. You can find it in Europe, Asia, and America. It does not only talk about expensive restaurants. It also shows simple places with good food. One special sign is the “Bib Gourmand”. This sign means good food at a good price.

Many people use the Michelin Guide when they travel. They want to eat good food and try new places. The guide helps them choose restaurants. Because of this, the Michelin Guide is very important in the food world.

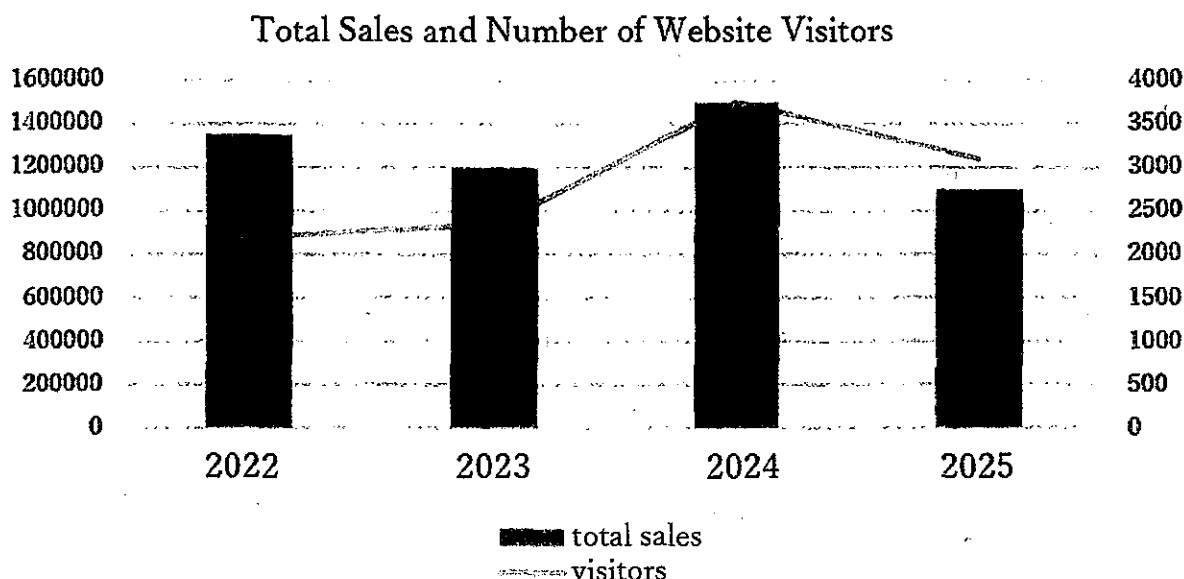
